

BY-LAW NO. 794

**A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF MILK RIVER TO REDUCE THE NUMBER OF COUNCILLORS REQUIRED TO SIT ON COUNCIL.**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Municipal Act, being Chapter M-26.1, R.S.A. 1994, the Council of a city or town consists of 7 councillors unless the council passes a by-law specifying a higher or lower odd number, and

**WHEREAS**, Council of the Town of Milk River deems it appropriate to reduce the number of Councillors.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the Town of Milk River duly assembled enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** the Council of the Town of Milk River consist of four Councillors all elected at large and one Mayor who shall be elected at large.
  2. **THAT** this by-law take effect with the next general election.
